Points for Discussion

1. Fill trays ahead of time with 2-3 options, students choose a tray.
2. Mobile computer lab in Westbrook at both campuses to free up a room; budget implication about \$20,000.
3. Include Asian foods in the lunch menu periodically.
4. Breakfast served in the elementary classrooms; read to students while they are eating.
5. One tech coordinator for the district.
6. Teachers have an office as opposed to a dedicated classroom; especially teachers who don't have a room at all.
7. Computer labs should not be assigned as classrooms.
8. Laptop computers for teachers who travel between buildings, or between classrooms.
9. Addition of students at Walnut Grove may necessitate having 2 lunch lines. Some renovations may need to be done to accommodate this; more servers too.
10. Lab assistant in each computer lab.
11. Auditorium at Westbrook could be used for 2 classes; curtain is somewhat soundproof.
12. Two internet computer labs at Walnut Grove.
13. Movement of students in buildings should be as seamless as possible; try to keep grade levels as segregated as possible.
14. Custodial needs will be about the same as there won't be any rooms shut down.
15. Walnut Grove custodial might increase because of increase in numbers.
16. Telemedia in Westbrook, change to a mobile lab.
17. If wrestling room is used as a classroom, get folding chairs with flip up desks and a mobile cart to put them on.
18. If elementary does not move to Walnut Grove we will need to add lockers in Westbrook in hall by gym for added students.
