

WWG GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS 2017-2018

In grades nine through twelve, students will be required to earn 32 credits unless an IEP (Individual Education Plan) has been written with alternate requirements.

09 - English I - 1.0 credit

10 - English II - 1.0 credit

11 and 12 - Speech (.5 credit) and 1.5 more credits from among three groups. .5 literature, .5 writing, .5 communications

09-12 Independent Reading Credit of .125 credit per semester for a total of 1.0 credit

3.5 credits in math in grades 9-12. Algebra I in grade 9 and Geometry and Algebra II are required.

09 - American History (post Civil War 1866-WWII) - 1.0 credit

10 - American History (WWII 1941 to the present) - 1.0 credit

11 - World History - 1.0 credit

12 - American Government (.5 credit) and Geography (.5 credit)

Life 101 - .25 credit per year on the topics of civic, personal and financial issues, and Medal of Honor character series.

09 - Biology - 1.0 credit

10 - Physical Science or Chemistry - 1.0 credit

11-12 - 1.5 additional Science credit (Career and Technical courses can be used as an alternative to completing chemistry or physics - 2012 State Law)

09-12 - Physical Education and health - 1.0 credit for class of 2019 & beyond

09-12 - 1.0 credit in Fine Arts from either music, visual art or theater

09 - Students must take two of three .5 credit vocational survey courses that include Agriculture, Family and Consumer Science (FACS), and Power Tools

Up to 2.0 credits may come from being a teacher's Peer Helper or Cadet.

Full time students are to take a minimum of 7.5 credits per year. Students must take competency tests in Writing (grade 11), Reading (grade 10) and Math (grade 11). There are alternate assessments available. (See MDE)
